Lining up in the Cry Room

Part 1: Report at 7:20 and get vested.

--Sit in your spot in order. Look through the glass and identify your seat in church.


--Locate the **things** you are responsible for (for example, the Holy Water buckets).

- --Review these notes. Any questions?
- --Pray for everyone who has asked for our prayers.
- --Know that you are **EVANGELIZING** by serving well.
 - You are helping people meet and get to know our Lord.
- --No Cross or Processional Candles on the way in, but YES WE DO on the way out.

Part 2: Procession TO THE BACK of church.


--We process in from the St. Joe Door, down the side aisle,

and take our positions around the center-back.



Part 3: at the Center-Back of church.

- --We process in from the St. Joe Door, down the side aisle, and take our positions around the center-back.
- --Fr. McCabe primes and ignites the Easter Fire.
- --Reading from the Book, the Presider blesses the **fire**, then the **Paschal Candle**.
- --The Presider lights his taper from the **Paschal Candle**. The Presider lights our tapers and we light each other's tapers. There are three tapers in the back for Presider, Concelebrant and **Paschal Candle**.




Part 4: Christ our Light.

--Incense leads Deacon Bob to Christ our Light 1, 2, 3.

--All light the people's tapers. 2 rows **ahead** is **OK**. Leap-frogging is **OK**.

--Paschal Candle lights tapers but also guards **Deacon Bob** and the Paschal Candle.




Part 5: the Exsultet.

--Incense goes to the Presider's Chair. Presider imposes incense. Incense goes to Paschal Candle stand.

 --Deacon Bob places the Paschal Candle in the stand, uses the incense, and gives the incense back to Incense.
--Incense stays put during the Exsultet. Swing the thurible a little, for safety.

--After lighting all the people's candles, the servers line up on the main floor. If you don't line up in the exact *order* in the picture below, **SO WHAT**. Pray. Listen carefully to the Exsultet.

--The EXSULTET is sung by the Music Ministry (from the loft).



Part 6: after the Exsultet, the Old Testament Readings.


--Sacristan turns ON the MASTER SWITCH and the SWITCH beneath.

--Incense takes the incense to the sacristy.

--We all stand at our seats.

When the Presider **puts out** his taper and **sits**, we do the same.

--After each reading, Book holds the Book for the Presider. We stand for a prayer. 1st Rdg: Genesis 2nd Rdg: Exodus 3rd Rdg: Isaiah





Part 7: the Gloria.

--As soon as the 3rd Reader (Isaiah) goes back to his/her seat,

Incense and Paschal Candle bring the long brass lighters to the Paschal Candle. Fire+Water1 and Fire+Water2 bring the short brass lighters to the Paschal Candle.


- --Paschal Candle lights his/her long lighter from the Paschal Candle, then lights the short lighters of Fire+Water1, Fire+Water2, and Incense.
- --Incense and Paschal Candle light the HIGH candles.
- --Fire+Water1 lights the ALTAR candles on the BVM side.
- --Fire+Water2 lights the ALTAR candles on the Sacristy.

--When the Gloria begins,

Fire+Bells rings the Bells for a count of 20.

- --Sacristan: All LIGHTS ARE TURNED ON.
- --Brass lighters are then returned to the sacristy.
- --After the Gloria, there is a prayer. **Book** holds the Book for the Presider.


Part 8: The Epistle and the Gospel.



--After the Gloria and Prayer, everyone *except* Incense sits for the Epistle (Romans). --Incense goes to the sacristy and gets ready for the Gospel.

--At the end of the Epistle, when the Reader returns to his/her seat, Incense goes to the chair. The Presider imposes Incense.

--Incense (but not Acolytes/candles) leads Deacon Bob to the ambo for the Gospel.



Part 9: the Homily.

--After the Gospel, Incense returns the incense to the sacristy.


On the way to the sacristy, *stop and bow* to the altar.

--The Presider preaches the Homily.

Part 10: the Baptismal Liturgy.

--After the Homily, the Presider goes to the Baptismal Font. Book and Paschal Candle come to the font too.

- --Deacon Bob calls forth the catechumens. The Godparents *might* present them.
- --The Presider makes an introductory statement.
- --The Music Ministry sings the Litany of Saints.
- --The Presider says a prayer, then **blesses the baptismal water**. During the blessing, he takes the **Paschal Candle**, dips it in the font and returns it.



--The Presider switches **Book** to *Ritual Book*, RCIA, page 140.

--The catechumens make a **Renunciation of Sin**.

- --If the catechumens were **not already anointed** with the **Oil of Catechumens**, they are now (page 56).
- --The catechumens make a Profession of Faith.


--Baptism is conferred, with the godparent's right hand on the catechumen's right shoulder.

--A white garment and lighted Baptismal candle are presented.

--The Paschal Candle now returns to its stand.

Part 11: the Rite of Confirmation.

- --The Presider goes to the steps in front of the Altar. **Does Father need Book? Book** goes to the Altar steps with the Presider.
- --If the Presider doesn't already have the **Sacred Chrism**, **Deacon Bob** brings it to him.
- --The Sacrament of Confirmation is administered. The candle lighting team gets ready with their tapers.
- --When the newly Confirmed are **dismissed to their seats**, the candle lighting team **GOES** and **relights** the people's candles.



Part 12: the Renewal of Baptismal Promises and Sprinkling Rite.

--With everyone's candles re-lit, the Presider leads the Renewal of Baptismal Promises.

--Fire+Water1 and Fire+Water2 get the holy water buckets and go with the priests.

--The Presider and Concelebrant sprinkle the people with Holy Water.



--When the Presider returns to his chair, **Book** holds the **book** for him.



Part 13: the hard stuff is over.

--The **Universal Prayer** (Prayer of the Faithful) comes next, and the Mass continues much like a Sunday.

--Incense at the Preparation of the Gifts.

--During Holy Communion, Acolyte1 and Acolyte2 get the Processional Candles from the sacristy and place them at their seats.

--At the Procession out

Incense, Cross with Cross, Acolytes with Processional Candles... Everyone else, be ready to **GENUFLECT** (since our hands are empty).
